You Can Expect....

- * In July, the **internal website** is updated for the new school year. When ready, that announcement will be emailed to Chance families.
- * In late July, the **“Back to School” E-News newsletter** is distributed.
- * In early August, **class lists and Parent/Student/Teacher Conference schedules** are distributed to Chance families. The Head of School is responsible for making class placement. Decisions are made over the summer months and are based upon information including but not limited to gender balance, diversity, class dynamics, and special considerations of individual students.

By July 1, we expect that your required student and parent forms will be on file in the school office. Thank you for meeting the deadline and helping the faculty and staff prepare for the start of school.

We must have valid, current forms on file for EACH student and for EACH parent for EACH school year. If not, school personnel reserve the right to refuse an adult’s or child’s attendance at/participation in school and related events.
